### President's Message



Dear Brothers and Sisters of the Lodge:

I would like to bring everyone up to date on "where we are today". As you all know, when we started this journey, we had little funds, catering dropped off, our gaming nights were on the brink of folding and the building

was in need of major repairs and to top it off, appliances needed to be replaced or repaired. Key people that made our Lodge so strong were stricken with various family or medical issues and forced to step back. It has been a struggle, but we have survived and I am happy to state, we are moving forward. Unfortunately, it has been through a small cadre of men and women, who are getting tired...as well as a bit older.

I am asking the members and our ladies of the Auxiliary to please give us some help. I realize each of us have our own problems and commitments to family, jobs, etc., but we need help in many ways. Just contact a committee chairperson and offer your time.

If you have a relative with a business, ask them to take an ad in our newsletter, or to sponsor a project or a scholarship.

We have our annual golf outing coming next month. We need help in many areas; people to work the course, serve the food and to sell (buy) sponsorships (e.g. tee, hole food sponsors). We could use golfers...

Bingo has been steadily moving up...but Andy could always use help. Bill needs help on the Vegas nights. At the beginning of the night we seem to have an abundance of workers, but as the night moves on, many leave and the last couple of hours are painful for those that remain. Sitting and dealing or working the wheels is tiring and everyone could use a break...even for just ten minutes; but lately, that is not happening.

Remember, the committee chair opens the hall around 4:30 PM and doesn't leave until the last person goes...for Bingo it is close to 11 PM and for Vegas it is later...around 12:30 AM. That is a long day.

At these same events food is prepared and served by a kitchen crew that starts at 5 PM and works all night to put the food out. Some of these members are working for the Lodge every Monday, Wednesday and every other Friday nights. Other members are here every day monitoring the kitchen, answering the phones and confirming the deliveries.

Weekly, we have members who shop for the food and then Roy Perticone cuts and trims the meats just to keep the cost down.

The upstairs room has been under renovation and it has been a long process because the few men doing the work have jobs and do the work when they can. Would any of you care to help? All you have to do is give some time and they will give you a job.

It is disturbing to see signs of carelessness like coffee stains on the wall where someone threw a cup in the trash and missed; or the stove in the small kitchen not cleaned after being used. These are things that lead to other problems. Everyone has to do their share and help.

Each month at the meetings, a financial report is read. You know we are not rolling in money; we are struggling each month to meet the monthly expenses.

Nearly every month we have some activity for the membership. Committee chairs go out of their way to make their function special. Many times buying items out of their own pocket just to keep the cost down.

The Lodge has tried to hold "socials" . . . inexpensive nights for you, the membership. Trips and Shows are arranged....for you the membership. But for these things to work, we need your support...both physically and financially. Running this Lodge is no easy task, and we are working hard to make things work, but we do need your help.

Please consider this and come forward to offer us your hand.




