President's Message



Dear Brothers and Sisters of the Lodge:

Growing up we all heard the term, "**many hands make for light work.**" As the President of the Lodge, I can fully understand the meaning.

Our Lodge was formed over 40 years ago and our building built nearly 35 years ago. Over that span, we have had many highs and lows; we have struggled through the tough times and flourished throughout the good times. We had taxes, utilities, insurance and food bills; proportionate to the times. Back then, this Lodge alone boasted of having over 400 members. Today, when you combine the Lodge and the Auxiliary, we have about 350 members.

What makes today different? Age...the building is older, the membership is older. Then, the average age of the membership was 45-50 years, today that average is up to 65-70 years. Listening to the senior members, they ran the same events we have today and when the night ended, they went to the local diner for breakfast; or they cooked it here in the Lodge. Today, our members just want to go home and go to bed. Why? Age.

The **Misiano's**, who are among the more senior of the members, are here every Monday (Bingo) and Friday (Vegas), doing whatever is asked of them...they are in their 80's. We have **World War II members** dealing cards at every Vegas, walking the floor at Bingo...they are in their 80's.

Our Officers are the members who choose to do more... and they do. During the week we have one **officer monitoring the house from 9 AM to 1 PM**. He answers the phone, signs for deliveries and is our representative to the public. Any problems he contacts me or the house chairman.

Every Monday night the **Bingo** staff, chaired by **Andy Filangeri**, opens the hall, prepares the prize monies, and runs the Bingo. They start about 4:30 PM and close down around 11 PM.

Vegas...every other Friday. A cadre of workers, chaired by **Bill Lamont** and **Virginia Usak** open the hall, set up the games and they hope for enough volunteers to run a successful night. Their night runs from 6 PM to after midnight.

The **Kitchen staff**...they probably put in more hours in a week than some put in for the year.

On Monday **Frank Montuori** will open up at 4:30 and begin to prepare for the meals they will serve that night.

Last call is usually about 9:15...by the time they clean up, it is almost 10 PM.

On Wednesday nights, our **Ballroom Dancing** ...a huge fund raiser started under President Clem and ran by Joe Commisso. Today, **Frank Montuori** runs the kitchen and is assisted by **Bill Lamont** and **Andy Filangeri**. They are part of a cadre of workers that start about 6 PM and end their night after 11 PM.

During the week, **Sal Picone** and **Roy Perticone** do the shopping and Roy butchers the meat for the weekend catering events. They do this voluntarily at their own expense. When something breaks or needs to be replaced, **Paul Carosotto** is the first one to try and repair it...to save us money. Space prohibits me from listing everyone who has contributed something to our Lodge, so I have singled out the people who chair these events. **The members of the Lodge and Auxiliary**, who work the Bingo, Vegas, Wednesday Dance are just as valuable and we can not thank you enough.

When we were younger, we were taught to give up a seat to an elderly or handicapped person. Today, we are all elderly and many of us are also handicapped, but we can still help or assist each other...**just give us your time and we all can get a break.**

Our Lodge is one of the finest in the State. We offer our members a warm and friendly environment in a beautiful building complete with a newly **re-furbished TV / Card room**, which was painted and dressed up by a couple of the Officers, **Tom Lorito** and **Jack Battaglia**. The room now has a beautiful pool table that was donated by **the Mangano family**.

During the year, we run inexpensive dances and family socials for less than a ticket to a ball game. We offer events that cater to all, such as golf outings, comedy shows, dances, etc. in order to raise money for the many charities and scholarships we support; and to pay taxes and utilities that are necessary to keep the building. Add to this, the age of the building and the variety of things that more frequently breakdown and you can see what a struggle it is.

WE NEED YOU TO HELP. So I am appealing to each of you, to contact the Chairpersons and make yourself available to help us out. Remember, this is your Lodge and just paying dues does not cover the work involved to maintain it.
