President's Message



Brothers and Sisters of the Lodge:

Daily, we are reminded of how important our health is to us. These past two years, I have seen illness and injury befall many of our members and all we could do was hope and pray they would get through it. In most cases, our prayers did some good, and many of these

fine people are recovering, but too many are still fighting the fight.

At a recent meeting, one of those members made a very moving appeal...he asked us all to realize that we can all give something other than prayers to help our fellow man. He asked if any of us ever read the back of our drivers license? Have you? He was speaking about the organ donor program, which reads: "I HEREBY MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT TO BE EFFECTIVE UPON MY DEATH, OF

A. Any Needed Organs or Parts

B. The Following Body Part(s)

C. Limitation(s).

It must be signed, dated and witnessed.

When questioned about age, he explained that age may not matter, depending on the organ, its need and availability.

Many of us never consider this, primarily because we are getting up in age, and like myself, felt this was something for younger and healthier people to consider. This is not so...you would be surprised at how the medical profession has advanced and can harvest many organs from older donors.

It is really quite easy, and it may work as well as the prayers we give. Please consider this act of kindness and maybe one day you can make the difference for someone suffering.

On another note, I must apologize to all of our members about our Phone Tree messages. Over the years, this has proven itself to be a wise investment. We all understand the value of communication and this is one of the many tools we use to "get the word out".

Unfortunately, the program we used got old and dated. Jim Caravella donated a new computer to us and then tried to import the files from the older one. When he could not transfer the files, they had to be re-entered into the new computer.

After this was done, we began experiencing problems. Unfortunately, they only happened periodically, meaning some messages went out and others only went out in part. We tried everything to correct this, but since it was not consistent, it was very difficult to fix. After many months of working with the tech support people from Phone Tree, we finally located one of the problems... the modem we were using was damaged.

Timing is everything, and when we needed this device, it finally failed. The message for the January 21 Vegas never went out. Fortunately, we discovered this early on Friday and was able to contact the Phone Tree Tech who walked us through the process to get that message out.

Friday evening, I was advised that the mother of past president Clem Oropallo had passed away. No matter how many people tried to get the phone tree to work, it was to no avail. We then asked our webmaster, Sal, to send out emails to all the members asking them to notify any members they knew. We apologize to the Oropallo family but there was nothing we could do. I sincerely hope enough people got the word and paid their respects.

About Our Heritage... Valentine's Day is not celebrated as fanatically in Italy as it is in the United States, though lovers do give flowers and candy. The Umbrian town of Terni, that claims Saint Valentino as their patron saint, celebrates with a torchlight parade. *Carnevale* is the passion and one of the most popular festivals all over Italy, with the most well known celebrations in Venice and Viareggio.

In Venice, the carnival starts two weeks before Ash Wednesday and ends on Shrove Tuesday (Fat Tuesday/ the day before Ash Wednesday). People in costumes wander about the city, amidst the nightly entertainment and events, which include gondola and boat parades along the Grand Canal; mask parades in St. Mark's Square and the children's carnival in the Cannaregio district.

Viareggio, on the Tuscany Coast, is famous for its giant paper mache` floats used in parades on Shrove Tuesday, three Sundays before and the Sunday that follows; concerts, cultural events and masked balls occur throughout this season.

Another February festival, in Catania, Sicily, celebrates Saint Agatha's Feast Day, the second largest religious procession in the world. Following a mass at dawn, on February 4th, the statue of St. Agatha, that houses her relics, is placed on a *fercolo* (a 40,000 pound silver carriage) and pulled up Monte Sangiuliano by 5,000 men. This festival lasts for two days and two nights, accompanied, of course, by eating and drinking. Very little was known of her other than she dedicated her life to God and resisted man's advances. She was tortured and sentenced to death by being rolled naked on a bed of hot coal, which began to tremble like an earthquake causing part of the wall to fall on her condemners. St. Agatha, a martyr, died at the age of 15 and is the patron saint of Catania.


