Staff Sergeant Salvatore Augustine Giunta received the first non-posthumous Medal of Honor since the Vietnam War (pictured, top right, with Mr. President; and below, with our own Mr. Immediate Past President).

Specialist Salvatore A. Giunta distinguished himself conspicuously by fearless courage, at the risk of his life, above and beyond the call of duty—in action, with an armed enemy in the Korengal Valley, Afghanistan, on October 25th, 2007. His citation of heroism takes more, in part, than I am able to print. It would be well worth your while to research further. Staff Sergeant Giunta is a true spirit of Italian Pride!

In addition to this prestigious award, The Sons of Italy Foundation will present him with a scholarship at the 23rd Annual National Education & Leadership Awards Gala (NELA).






