## About Our Heritage . . . 150 YEARS' UNITY CELEBRATION & FATHER'S DAY

On March 17, 1861, the kingdom of Italy was proclaimed and Turin named its first capital. On that day, Victor Emmanuel II became the first king of a unified Italy. It was the culmination of the *Risorgimento*, the movement for independence that for years struggled to free the country from foreign rule. Prior, the country had been a patchwork of regions ruled by the Pope and various monarchs. Four years after Turin was named first capital, Florence was named, in 1865; and subsequently in 1871, Rome.

As we thumb through pages of this June issue, preparations will be made for Father's Day . . . a day to celebrate our fathers and the influence of our forefathers. However, our Italian forefathers observed early Catholic tradition and celebrated *Festa del Papa* on March 19<sup>th</sup>, Saint Joseph's Day; and a grand old feast it is. Several days of live music, dancing, food and drink fill the streets of Florence and Rome, as San Giuseppe desserts vary from region to region, with zeppole and bigne (cream puffs) in the south and frittelle in the north.

Italy's big celebration in June is the San Giovanni Feast Day, where hundreds of tiny lamps float on Lake Como; and in Florence, a palio of rowboats carrying lit candles can be found on the Arno River.
