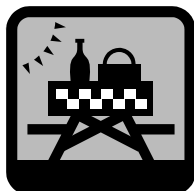

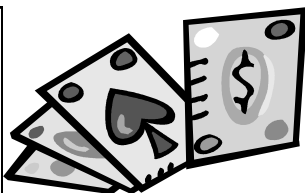

### *About Our Heritage . . . Festa della Madonna delle Neve on August 5th*

celebrates the miraculous summer snowfall in the fourth century that prompted the building of one of the four patriarchal churches of Rome, *Santa Maria Maggiore*.

According to legend, a rich gentleman, Giovanni dreamt that it would snow on August 5th in Rome; and on the site where it would fall, a church should be erected in honor of the Madonna. Pope Liberio had the same dream. The next morning they followed their dream to the site and was amazed to find almost an inch of snow. The Pope got down on hands and knees and traced the outline in the snow for the new church, the *Basilica Liberiana*, rebuilt in 432 A.D. as *Santa Maria Maggiore*.

For the past 25 years, on August 5th, in Piazza Santa Maria Maggiore, at sunset, the feast of Our Lady of Snows is celebrated with festivities which end with the traditional annual snowfall of petals of white roses.
