

About Our Heritage... The Christmas season in Italy runs for three weeks, starting eight days before Christmas, known as the Novena. During this period, children go from house to house dressed as shepherds, reciting poems.

Christmas, known as the Novena. During this period, children go from house to house dressed as shepherds, reciting poems and singing. In the regions of Calabria and Abruzzo, and in the piazzas of Rome, the *zampognari* (shepherds who play bagpipes) come down from their mountain homes to perform.



A strict feast is observed 24 hours before Christmas Eve, followed by a celebration meal featuring panettone and chocolate.

Presents and empty boxes are drawn from the *Urn of Fate*, which contains one gift per person. By twilight, candles are lit around the presepio (family crib) and prayers are said. At noon on Christmas day, the pope blesses the crowds gathered in Vatican Square.

There is no Santa Claus in Italy, though a version of him, Babbo Natale (Father Christmas) is growing in popularity.

The children wait until the Epiphany for their presents. According to tradition, presents are delivered by a witch known as *La Befana*, who arrives on a broomstick during the night of January 5th and fills stockings with toys and sweets for the good children and lumps of coal for the bad ones. Legend has it that the night before the Wise Men arrived at the Manger, they stopped at a shack to ask the old woman for directions. They then invited her to come along, but she claimed to be too busy. The shepherd asked a second time and she refused. Later that night she saw a great light in the sky and decided to join the Wise Men and shepherd bearing gifts that belonged to her dead child. She got lost and never found the manger. Now *La Befana* flies on her broomstick each year on the eleventh night, bringing gifts in hope to find the Baby Jesus.






