



About Our Heritage . . .

Who's Who in our Culture?

Born February 18, 1745,

Alessandro Giuseppe Antonio Anastasio Gerolamo Umberto Volta, in Como, Lombardy, Italy. He did not speak until the age of four and appeared to be mentally backward; but by seven he was at the level of other children and soon began to overtake them. His parents were not wealthy, but with the help of relatives, sent him to the Royal Seminary in Como, with the intention that he would enter the legal profession. However, at an early age, Volta had decided to pursue chemistry and physics as a



career. In 1763 he began to correspond with noted French physicist Abbe Antoine Nollet, suggesting an analogy between electrical and gravitational forces. In 1774, he was appointed professor of physics at the Royal School and designed his first invention, the electrophorus, a device that produced static electricity. For years thereafter, he studied the chemistry of gases and experimented with atmospheric electricity by igniting static sparks. In 1779, Volta was appointed professor of physics at the University of Pavia, where he invented his most famous invention, the voltaic pile; the first battery to produce a reliable, steady current of electricity. Volta revolutionized science and technology by his invention of the electric battery, which he sometimes judged by the flash he saw as he touched its wires to his eyelids.

Volt—the unit of electromotive force, or difference of potential, which will cause a current of one ampere to flow through a resistance of one ohm . . . is named for Italian physicist Alessandro Volta.




