About Our Heritage . . .

Saint Joseph's Day

March 19th was dedicated to Saint Joseph in several Western calendars by the tenth century. The custom was established in Rome by 1479 and Pope Pius V extended it to the entire Roman Rite by his Apostolic Constitution *Quo Primum*, July 14, 1570.

In Sicily, St. Joseph is regarded by many as their Patron Saint and these Italian communities give thanks to San Giuseppe for preventing a famine in Sicily during the Middle Ages. According to legend, there was a severe drought and the people prayed for their patron saint to bring rain. They promised, if he answered their prayers, to prepare a large feast in his honor. The rain came and the people of Sicily prepared a large banquet for their patron saint. The fava bean was the crop which saved the population from starvation and is a traditional part of St. Joseph's day altars, along with flowers, lime, candles, wine, specially prepared cakes, breads and cookies. Foods are served with bread crumbs representing saw dust, as St. Joseph was a carpenter. The altar, customarily, has three tiers to represent the Holy Trinity.

Some villages like Belmonte Mezzagno celebrate in a different way, burning wood and logs in squares, on the eve, as thanksgiving . . .

A Vampa di San Giuseppe (St. Joseph's bonfire).

And don't forget those sweets, especially the Sicilian pastry zeppola. St. Joseph was also the patron saint of pastry chefs! ~ *Bob Sarino*
