About Our Heritage . . . Emilia-Romagna is comprised of those two historic regions. Bologna is the capital.

The Romans built the Aemilian Way, for which the region was named, connecting Rome to the Northern part of Italy. The coastal area of Emilia, which was ruled under the Byzantines from 540 to 751, became known as the separate region of Romagna. The region of Emilia-Romagna consists of nine provinces (Bologna, Ferrara, Forli-Cesena, Modena, Parma, Piacenza, Ravenna, Regio Emilia and Rimini). Combined they cover an area of more than 8,000 miles, ranking 6th in Italy. Nearly half the region is plains; the other, hills and mountains. Emilia-Romagna, today, is considered as one of the richest and most developed regions in Europe and has the third highest GDP (gross domestic product) per capita in Italy.

On Sunday, 20 MAY 2012, this northern Italian region was shaken by an earthquake. It was reported that at least five lives were lost, more were injured and thousands left homeless. Some of the worst damage fell upon buildings of historic significance to the region. The 14th century Estense Castle in San Felice sul Panaro was severely damaged and parts of another medieval castle in the town of Finale Emelia collapsed. The Sons of Italy announced intention to establish an 'Earthquake Relief Effort' to assist victims and inhabitants of areas

most affected.




