About Our Heritage . . . The "Presepio" (Nativity Scene)

The "Presepio" is one of the oldest Christian traditions that has truly had an international impact. It has been in churches for centuries, beginning with the veneration in the grotto in Bethlehem. It was Constantine who built the Basilica of the Nativity in 326 A.D. over the present grotto, but the first *presepio* was made seven hundred years later in Rome, in the Basilica of Saint Maria Maggiore. The idea spread quickly to other churches. All were extravagant with gold, silver, other precious stones and carvings.

These *presepio*s were so far removed from the actual cave at Bethlehem that St. Francis of Assisi, in 1223, asked Giovanni Vellita to prepare the first-ever *presepio* for the townspeople of Greccio. He introduced the tradition to make the story of Jesus' birth vivid to his followers. In the woods near the church of Greccio, a manger was made with hay, an ox and an ass (legend has it that the ox and the ass warmed the child with their breath). St. Francis used townspeople to play the part of Jesus, Mary, Joseph, the Wise Men and shepherds.

Today, nativity scenes are common, often substituting carved figures with people.

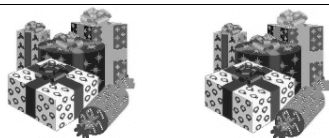

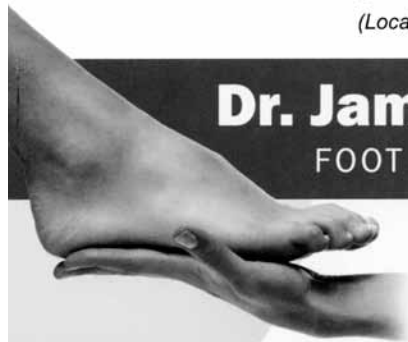
