

About Our Heritage . . . February . . . Football and Italian American Stars of the Game



February begins with ground hogs casting shadows (or not) on the forecast for Spring; and Super Bowl Sunday. Parties fill homes and local sports bars; and occasionally fans will get reminiscent of all-time favorite players. Many Italian Americans are amongst those memories. Most of us remember John Cappalletti, Franco Harris, Brian Piccolo and Andy Robustelli, but fewer may remember Leo Nomellini.

Leo Joseph Nomellini was born 1924 in Lucca, Italy. He was two years old when his family moved to the United States. Because he had to work to help support them, Nomellini had to pass up high school football. In 1943, he enlisted in the Marine Corps and served in the South Pacific as an aviation mechanic and specialist. In 1946, he was

reassigned to Cherry Point, N.C. where he would play his first football game. After his discharge, that year, he was awarded a football scholarship from the University of Minnesota. There, as an offensive tackle, he became a two-time All-American (1948 & 1949). He also was on the track team as a shot-putter and anchorman on the 440-yard relay team.

Nomellini went on to become the San Francisco 49ers' first ever NFL draft choice in 1950. He played every 49ers' game for 14 seasons, tagged "indestructible." During the off-season Nomellini wrestled professionally as Leo "the Lion" Nomellini, winning the Big 10 Heavy-weight Championship and 8 World Tag Team Championships. He was an excellent defensive pass rusher and bulldozing offensive blocker; a 10-time Pro Bowler & 6-time First-Team All-Pro (2 years on offense, 4 years on defense).

In 1969, Nomellini was enshrined in the Pro Football Hall of Fame and #73 was retired He died in 2000, at the age of 76.


