



About Our Heritage . . .

March 9 - Feast of Santa Francesca Romana

Santa Francesca Romana (Saint Frances of Rome) is an Italian saint who was a wife, mother, mystic, organizer of charitable services and a Benedictine oblate, who founded a religious community of vowed oblates. She was born in the district of Parione Rome and christened in the Church of Saint Agnes on the famed Piazza Navona. At eleven years old she wanted to become a nun, but by the age of twelve, her parents forced her to marry Lorenzo Ponziani, Commander of the papal troops of Rome.

Frances experienced many sorrows during her marriage. Her and Lorenzo lost two children to the plague and during one occupation of Rome by Neapolitan forces, Lorenzo was so severely wounded that he never recovered. During the period civil chaos ruled the city, with various forces competing for power on the Italian peninsula, Frances prayed, visited the poor and took care of the sick, becoming an inspiration to other wealthy women. On the Feast of the Assumption (1425) she founded the Olivetan Oblates of Mary confraternity and in 1433 founded a monastery at Tor de' Speechi, near the Campidoglio, to allow for a common life for its members.. In 1608 she was canonized by Pope Paul V. In 1925 Pope Pius XI declared her the patron saint of automobile drivers, because of a legend that an angel would light the road before her with a lantern when she traveled, keeping her safe from hazards. On March 9th, her feast day, Romans drive to Piazzale del Colosseo near the church of Santa Francesca Romana to have their cars blessed..
