

About Our Heritage . . . May . . . Mother's Day . . . La Festa dell'a Mamma



Like most feast days in Italy, Mother's Day can be traced back to ancient Roman culture when an entire week of celebrations were held in May to honor the goddess Juno. Juno, whose name means 'vital force' - a great description for Italian mothers - was the Roman goddess of marriage and motherhood. The tradition of ancient Roman weddings, to ensure a good marriage and fertility, was to marry in Juno's month (June) - a tradition still preserved in Italian weddings.

While Mother's Day had not been adopted in Italy until 1957, it has now become one of the most popular of all Italian family traditions.

There is definitely a link between the worship of the Madonna (symbol of perfect motherhood) and the reverence for mothers in Italy. Italian mothers are the pillars of strength, not only of the family, but also the community . . . and not only in Italy, but wherever in the world they may be.

La mamma will not be permitted to do any housework on her special day. Breakfast will be made for her and children will offer her home-made gifts of cards and flowers. Lunch will be served at home or, more increasingly popular, at a local restaurant. Wherever it's held flowers will be on the table surrounded by simple food.

Mother's day has become the most popular day in the year to dine out in Italy and Italian phone companies record the highest volume of calls.






