About Our Herítage . . . Festa del Papa

Father's day is a celebration honoring and celebrating fatherhood, paternal bonds and the influence of fathers in society. Many countries celebrate it on the third Sunday in June, but in Italy, according to the Roman Catholic tradition, fathers are celebrated on Saint Joseph's day, commonly know as the Feast of Saint Joseph ("Festa di San Giuseppe"), on March 19th. The origin dates back to when there was a terrible drought in Sicily. The people prayed to St. Joseph, asking him to bring rain. When the rains came, the people celebrated and prepared a large feast to thank him. Large tables of food were prepared in public and crowds of people gathered to celebrate and feast, alongside with the poor people. It is customary, on this day, to donate food, as was done at the original feast.

Of course, any celebration in Italy includes food. Households prepare traditional spreads of special Italian breads and cookies. In the south, zeppole; and bigné are prepared in the north. (One legend recounts St. Joseph prepared and sold bigné himself, while unemployed as a carpenter). Fritters are also served to mark this occasion. In some places bonfires are lit up or pageants celebrate the day; and in some parts of Italy, traditional donkey races are held. But, in all of Italy, this is the day when families show their gratitude to their fathers with favors and gifts. $\sim \mathcal{B}ob\ Savino$
