They demonstrated Brumidi support in numbers; and our ladies attracted a steady flow of 'contributors' to the roulette wheels. Although I would have liked to see a better turnout at the L.I. Columbus Day Parade, those who were there proudly marched with our banners and flags, followed by our vehicle riders.

Halloween was a blast, as always, and the committee did a great job. However, I was amiss in not thanking our Chairman Danny, who is always there, no matter which way I turn for help.
