As Blake professes, I share my final message as President with heartfelt thanks. I couldn't possibly name you all with the risk of leaving out someone special. So, excuse me if I refer to you all as the 'usual suspects'. . . those who were there when needed and those who were always there.

The journey began with some difficulty. The economy hurt our Catering business as well as the attendance at in-house events; not any different from other businesses/organizations. A three-part plan was immediately developed to include short term, mid-range and long term objectives. The short term was achieved, reducing taxes by \$8,000/year and implementing an additional \$17,000 savings from other initiatives. Mid-range, we revisited an extension on the cell tower and we are currently in lease negotiations with AT&T, which, added to our existing lease, is estimated to pay for our taxes. Based on the assertiveness of this administration and our partnership with the Town of Babylon, the once-mentioned sale of the building is no longer in the picture for the near future; but instead, we are pursuing a 'go green' energy savings program, to further reduce utility expenses.

The focus on my term was to put the Lodge in a better financial position. This past administration did that and you should be as proud of them as I am.

You've heard this from me consistently . . . your support, as members is critical to the sustainability of our Lodge. You now have a new President at the helm, one who is the best choice to effectively move this Lodge into the future. Let's move forward together.

Keep in your prayers our Brothers & Sisters who are sick; our deceased members; and service men & women serving worldwide.

### *About Our Heritage . . . A celebration of Monte San Savino*

Monte San Savino is a town and commune in the province of Arezzo, Tuscany. It rises in the valley of Chiana, on a hill dominating the valley of the Esse torrent.

In the 13th century it was a possession of the Ubertini, lords of Arezzo, but in 1325, because it sided with the Guelphs supported by Florence and Guido Tarlati (Ghibelline bishop of Arezzo), had the castle walls knocked down. In 1337, the town became a dominion of Perugia, then belonged to Siena and finally to Florence in 1384. In 1550, Duke Cosimo de' Medici granted Monte San Savino, as a personal feudal estate to Baldovino del Monte, brother of Pope Julius III. The estate was ruled by the Orsini marquises, Mattias de Medici and Vittoria della Rovere until it was restored to grand-ducal dominion in 1748. In 1991, Monte San Savino was granted the title of city by decree of the President of the Republic.

The economy is largely based on the production of cereals, fruit, vegetables, grapes, olives and sugar beets; and famous for celebrating *Sagra della Porchetta Savinese*, the wood oven roasting of pigs in open air markets and sausage based on pork meat made according to some ancient and traditional recipes. There are also many factories manufacturing pottery, furniture and frames.

The first settlements in the territory on Monte San Savino most likely go back to the age of Etruscans..

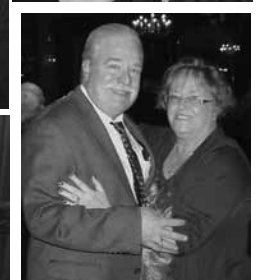

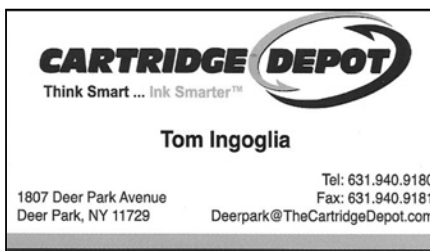

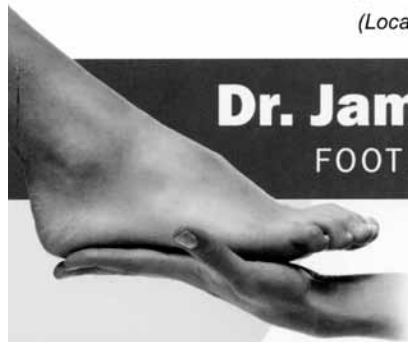
