About Our Heritage . . . And the Holidays of Thanksgiving and Christmas

Italians living in Italy do not celebrate Thanksgiving. Instead, they have many holidays called *La Festa del Ringraziamento* (Festival of Thanks), celebrated throughout the year to honor patron saints. So, Italians in America follow the turkey tradition started by the colonists and Wampanoag Indians; and enjoy the Macy's parade and football.

However, when Christmas Eve arrives, many Italian Americans celebrate with the *Festa dei Sette Pesci* (Feast of Seven Fishes), which originates from southern Italy, where it is known as *La Vigilia* (The Vigil). This celebration dates back to the Roman Catholic tradition of abstinence. While this feast was brought over to the USA by Italian immigrants in the 1800's, it now seems more popular in America than it is in Italy.

And then . . . it is Christmas morning, when the Baby Jesus arrives in the crib. The city of Naples is world-famous for crib-making. The first crib scene there was said to go back to 1025 in the Church of S. Maria del Presepe (Saint Mary of the Crib); and using the crib to tell the Christmas story was made popular by St. Francis of Assisi in 1223.

Your dues are the same as Lodge members. Reference instructions above. See Daniel Calise for payment.

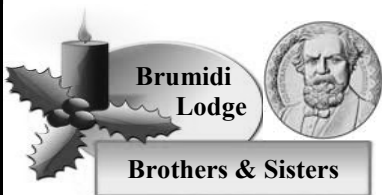

I still don't know when I will be able to "work" a full day, each day is different, but between the physical therapy and exercise, I am getting stronger each week. ~ John Vigiano


