About Our Heritage . . . "When you see a fork in the road, take it!" ~ Yogi Berra

It's time for Major League pitchers & catchers to arrive at Spring training and almost time for me to assess if I'm ready to field the game another year. My fondest memories of the game were my teacher and my team. My teacher was my father, strong-willed to make me a switch-hitter; and he succeeded. Our team was the NY Yankees. In our family there was no other team; and Yogi was a household favorite.

Lawrence Peter Berra was born in 1925, in a primarily Italian neighborhood of St. Louis called 'The Hill', to Italian immigrants Pietro & Paolina Berra.

Yogi began playing baseball, locally, in American Legion leagues, where he learned the basics of catching, while playing infield and outfield positions. It was there he was given his nickname, from his friend Bobby Hofman, who said he resembled a Hindu yogi whenever he would sit, with arms & legs crossed, waiting to bat or looking sad after losing a game.

Berra served in the U.S. Navy, during WWII, during the D-Day invasion. As a major league player, he became the master of hitting poor pitches. In 1972, he became the manager of the NY Mets, after the sudden death of Gil Hodges. That same year, he was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame (as a Yankee) and his number (8) was retired.

Berra remains involved in causes related to his Italian American heritage, a long time supporter of the National Italian American Foundation (NIAF), receiver of the NIAF Special Achievement Award for Sports.




