About Our Heritage ... While November 11th is Veterans day, we should remember our veterans every day.

Throughout various wars, some heroes are less glorified than others. Captain Dominic Salvatore Gentile was one. Born in Piqua, Ohio, the son of southern Italian immigrants, he became fascinated with flying as a child, playing with kites and model planes as a teen. At the outbreak of the war in1941,his desire to join the USAF was stifled by military requirements of two years of college for pilots. Dominic then enlisted in the RAF and joined the legendary Eagle Squadrons of England. Shortly after, in one ten-minute span, he downed two German planes over France, earning the British Distinguished Flying Cross. He would soon transfer into the USAF and take part in some of the great aerial combat missions of the war. Some of the then-unconventional air combat tactics employed by Gentile and his wingman, were later used in Vietnam by U.S. fighter pilots.

At 33, Captain Dominic Gentile made his last flight, crashing a T-33 trainer. His decorations include the Distinguished Service Cross, the Silver Star, the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Air Medal, the Presidential Unit Citation, the WWII Victory Medal, the American Campaign Medal, the British Star, the Eagle Squadron Crest . . . and more.

He is remembered today as one of America's great combat aviators. The Ace of Aces.

Art VI, B.L.1:

Art. IV, B.L.4:

C. Only candidates who have appeared before the nominating committee and have been rejected by said committee will be eligible to accept a nomination to run off the floor for a Corporation Board Director position.


