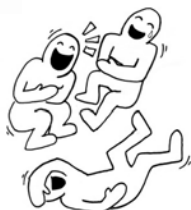

Art. IV, B.L.4:

- C. *Only candidates who have appeared before the nominating committee and have been rejected by said committee will be eligible to accept a nomination to run off the floor for a Corporation Board Director position.*
