



BRUMIDI BYLAW PROPOSAL CHANGES

- **1.** All Past Presidents will pay \$40.00 per year to cover the OSIA per capita tax. If not paid on time membership will be considered in arrears.
- **2.** Membership dues will increase from \$75.00 to \$80.00. For members 62 years or older, with 5 years of membership in the Brumidi Lodge, dues will increase from \$45.00 to \$50.00 If dues are not paid on time membership will be considered in arrears.
- **3.** If two (2) members from the same family join <u>at the same time</u>, **one** of the \$50.00 installation fees will be waived.

Proposed Bylaw changes have been drafted and approved by the Brumidi Bylaw Committee and unanimously approved by the Board of Trustees.

If ALL or PART of these recommended Bylaw Changes are approved by the General Membership, they will not take affect until January, 2018.
