

It would be fiscally irresponsible. The trustees made the correct decision and we cannot tell you at this time when we will resume printing and mailing. I urge you to please come to our meetings when you feel comfortable enough. These coming months will shed light on our future here at the Brumidi Lodge. Hopefully, New York State restrictions will end soon and we can try to get back to normal. This however will take much time and effort. I thank you for you continued support of our fundraisers. Remember, the more you support our programs, the quicker we can get back on our feet. The Directors of your lodge met on the fourth Monday in August to come up with alternate plans to our financial problems. We will be presenting these plans and ideas to the membership during the next few months. Please stay tuned for the forthcoming ideas/opportunities.

Our summer season passed by slower this year, due to our isolation during the pandemic. Although it was delayed several months, we were able to honor our 2020 Scholarship winners at our general business meeting in August. Thank you to my wife Susan and her committee for another job well done. Our Memorial Mass has been cancelled due to the pandemic and in 2021 we will hopefully hold our Mass for our departed members for 2019-2020 and 2020-2021. Our Day at the Races on August 23 was a huge success due to the work of the committee and most of all the guests that attended. Social distancing was followed and everyone had a good time. By the time you read this message, I hope we were semi successful with our Craft Night, and our Lodge Barbecue.

Our Meals on Wheels take-out food program has been successful and we shall try to have one every two weeks if we have volunteers to help in the kitchen. Please contact Daniel Calise if you can help cook or prepare the dinners in our kitchen. Brumidi Catering is now offering "Off-Premise Catering." Make sure you pick up our new catering brochure at the lodge. Please talk this up to your family and friends.

September and October usually come with many events and important dates. However, I am sorry to say that due to the pandemic, we are limited to what we can do as a lodge. By now you should be aware that both the New York City and Town of Huntington Columbus Day Parades have been cancelled. This is not due to any protests but a result of the ongoing pandemic. They should both resume next year. October is traditionally our Culture and Heritage month. At our General membership meeting on October 20th, we will attempt to serve Traditional Italian food to celebrate our culture. We will not be hosting vendors from the community as we have done in the past. The plan is to showcase some of the Brumidi off premise catering Menu. If you would like to make an antipasta, entrée, or dessert for this evening, please contact house chair Frank Montuori so he can properly coordinate the effort.

Remember, member recruitment is ongoing. We recruited some interested future members at our Day at the Races. I continue to challenge each of you to get one family member or friend as a new member of our lodge. The membership is the strength of any lodge. Let's continue to build a strong fraternal bond amongst our membership and promote our lodge. Also please remember that during the next few months, we will be attempting to put together food baskets for the needy in our community. Just like our lodge, many families are financially strapped this year. Please remember and pray for those families and consider putting some food items aside for any upcoming food drives.






