

President's Message



My Brothers and Sisters,

This time last year, I believe I started my article with, "Can someone explain to me where 2019 went?" This year, 2020, moved much slower due to all the restrictions, complications, and safeguards regarding the pandemic across our great Country. Politics and other issues got out of hand.

Due to the continuing financial issues, I am sorry to report that I cannot determine at this time when we will start to print and mail out the LaVoce again.

Our Culture and Heritage night on October 20th was a success considering the current circumstances. To help stay safe, we did not arrange for any outside vendors this year but showcased our own Brumidi Catering. Our event was sponsored by Town of Babylon Councilman and lodge member Anthony Manetta. Anthony joined us that evening and made a much needed donation to our lodge. He was also honored as our October Member of the Month. We installed our beautiful Lodge Queen , Sophia Petri, and presented her with her tiara and flowers which were graciously donated by member Janet Dickert. Sophia is the granddaughter of member Angela Petri. We also had a very informative presentation from Bob & Sabrina Savino on Culture and Heritage. Members brought homemade Italian desserts to finish off a lovely evening.

Due to the ongoing restrictions of the COVID-19 Pandemic, we will have a different holiday schedule this year. We will start our season off with our traditional Trim-a-Tree night on November 27th. This will get our hall ready for the Christmas Season. This year we will not be having a Seniors Christmas party. We are still working on the details of a possible breakfast with Santa. It will not be our traditional inside sit down event but a meals on wheels brunch with a gift presented to the children by Santa outside as the cars pull up for their pre-ordered meals. We are also working on a possible Christmas

Brunch for our Christmas Party. We will be having an Officer's Christmas party but this will be limited to current officers only and each guest will be contributing towards the cost of the party due to the current financial situation. Our annual New Year's Eve party is cancelled this year. These decisions were made due to our limit of 50 guests maximum and the prohibition of dancing. These are also the reasons for cancelling the Halloween Dance.

Other changes this year include the cancellation of the Huntington Columbus Day Parade. However, I did represent the lodge in a wreath laying ceremony in Huntington on Sunday, October 11th at the Columbus Statue in Huntington. This event was limited to State Officers and Lodge Presidents. On November 7th, we are hosting another game night. This time it will be "Survey Says" a modified version of Family Feud where each team attempts to pick the most popular answers to a question. You will love this game. Each team has a chance to pick a number from the main screen revealing the next question in the contest. Remember to sign up early because we are limited to a certain number of participants.

As 2020 comes to an end, we do have something for which to be thankful. We should be thankful for the core group of Officers and Directors of this lodge who continue to give and work week after week to keep our lodge afloat during this financial crisis. 


