

Poetry ... Poesia

Poets across the states celebrate National Poetry Month in April.

However, the jubilee, this year will begin in March, with Dante. Of the Italian Triumvirate of Dante, Petrarch and Boccaccio, known as the three crowns (*tre corone*) Dante Alighieri was also known as the Supreme Poet (*il Sommo Poeta*) among the greatest poets of Italian and world literature.

He was born in Florence in 1265, and died in exile in Ravenna in 1321. His tomb is still in Ravenna. It was during exile that Dante composed his greatest work, *The Divine Comedy*, a medieval literary bridge to the Renaissance era, his vision of the afterlife where references to myth, history and scripture serve to comment on the politics and political figures of his day. As a result of this body of work, Florentine Tuscan became the lingua franca, laying the foundation for the Italian language spoken today.

This year marks the 700th anniversary of the medieval poet and philosopher's death and the Italian government has announced the establishment of a National Dante Day, or *Dantedi*, to be observed annually on March 25. It was this date that scholars recognize as the beginning of Dante's journey into Hell, Purgatory and Paradise, the afterlife of the Divine Comedy.

"Dante reminds us of many things that hold us together: Dante is the unity of the country, Dante is the Italian language, Dante is the very idea of Italy", says Italian culture minister Dario Franceschini.

In a time when our Italian heritage is being challenged, it is a perfect time to allow poetic expression to fill your heart.
