
Dance is back! We are following NYS Protocols to keep our members and guests safe.

Genealogy – With an analysis of NYC Buildings in the 1940's By Carmine E. Soldano, Immediate Past President

The purpose of writing this article is basically two fold: First, as Immediate Past President, my devotion to the lodge still exists but it does free up an extra hour or so during my busy day to devote more time to hobbies and other personal interests that have been set aside while President of our lodge. One of those interests is Genealogy. I have been working on my family's Genealogy for over 30 years now. I was fortunate enough to interview Aunts and Uncles over the years to obtain information that would be impossible to obtain today.

That being said, I recently started a new branch of my family research that I would like to share with you. This past year, New York City released a website of Tax photos taken between 1939 and 1941



by the Works Progress Administration, in conjunction with the New York City Department of Taxation. The two entities organized teams of photographers to shoot pictures of every building in the five boroughs of New York City. The photographs were taken to improve the process of determining and recording property value assessments. This turned out to be a hidden treasure to a genealogist. I looked up and retrieved photos from this site of the homes that my family members were born in and /or grew up in. I also obtained photos of churches that my family ascendants were married in and places of employment. It was a great find and you could spend months looking at what NYC looked like in the 1940's. I have added such photos to my Family Tree Maker along with corresponding stories of individual family members.

Secondly, in looking at buildings and structures from that era, I found a clear photo of the Garibaldi Meucci Museum at its present location in Staten Island. The photo shows a Pantheon-like structure over the original house. Apparently, in 1906, the Garibaldi Society of Staten Island raised \$9,000 to move the house two blocks to its present site and protect it with this columned dome stucco and wood structure. I found this very interesting. It eventually had to be removed due to termite infestation. This is just one example of looking back in time in New York City. I welcome all my brothers and sisters to check out this useful tool at https://1940s.nyc.






