



Forty Days to Easter in Italy

Known as *Quaresima*, or the 40th day, in Italian, Lent is the word Catholics use to describe the fast before Easter. Forty is a significant number in the Bible, including, Moses on the mountain for 40 days, rain for 40 days and nights in the story of Noah's Ark, and 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness praying and fasting. The intention is to abstain from certain things, especially on Fridays, as penance for our sins, and to reflect on Jesus' resurrection.

Today, many Catholics - including many Italians - still make sacrifices. The most well-known is refraining from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and every Friday until Easter.

Additionally, most Catholics choose to either do a good deed (volunteering at a hospital, donating food and supplies to the poor, etc.) or to give up something they love (chocolate, watching television) during Lent. The intention is to make a sacrifice like the one Jesus made for us.

When Holy Week arrives, churches tend to fill more than usual on Palm Sunday, bottles of holy water are usually blessed and offered to Mass.

Sunday, bottles of holy water are usually blessed and offered to Mass attendants, and processions (often outdoors) include the Stations of the Cross.

As Easter approaches, Italians traditionalists prepare for a big feast. Many of them collect red onion skins that they use to dye Easter eggs. Hardly anyone uses store-bought dyes, which they consider to be poisonous. Children wake to chocolate eggs. The bakers begin to soak wheat for *pastiera* or wheat pie, which is a typical Neapolitan dessert.

One of the most enjoyable occasions in Italy is the Easter celebration. Pasqua is an important tradition in Italy. The holiday symbolizes the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ in the Christian. Historically, Easter holiday was marked on every Sunday after the first full moon in spring equinox.

Each Italian town holds its own colorful procession on the Easter Sunday with thousands of performances depicting the crucifixion and resurrection of Christ. Statues of Jesus and Virgin Mary are paraded throughout the city while jovial participants dressed in ancient forms of clothing carry olive branches singing religious songs.

Most importantly, Easter is a confirmation of our faith.




