

In October, Italian American Heritage month celebrates the distinguished cultural contributions of Americans of Italian descent.

In the late 1800's Italian immigrants came to America in search of work; to make a living. During that period of immigration they were exposed to a wave of prejudice and hostility and settled into isolated tenement neighborhoods with family and friends. These immigrants mostly became laborers and construction workers focusing on the structure of New York City buildings.

In time, their hard work was rewarded with economic success. Their children and grandchildren became educated and entered various sectors of the workforce, however, for a long time thereafter, discrimination prevented them from achieving top-level corporate positions.

We are the descendants of those proud but poor people whose values were rooted in love of family, strong work ethic and religious devotion.

In October, Italians also celebrate Christopher Columbus whose exploration and colonization was significant in creating the modern Western World.

For years, NYS Order Sons and Daughters of Italy in America, celebrated the founding of their own Cristoforo Colombo, in Brother Lou Gallo, who embodied the Admiral of the Ocean Sea in so many ways, while keeping the spirit of Italian American culture and heritage close to our hearts.

This year we will miss the presence of Lou, but never forget him or the immigrants who forged the path for the lives we have today.

Italian Heritage Annual Flag Fundraiser Celebrating our Italian Heritage Month October




