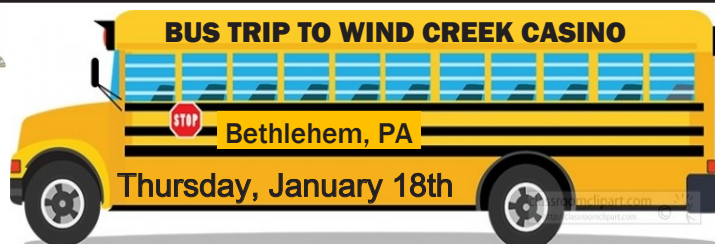

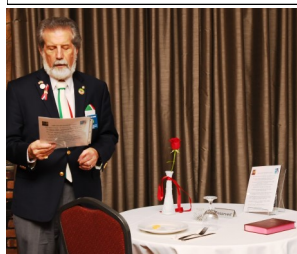

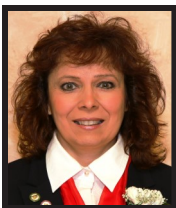

We are always looking for new fundraising ideas to promote our Italian American culture, sustain our building, and to support the community. Submit suggestions to any member of the Lodge Board.

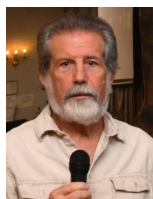
In the spirit of fraternity, please consider reaching out to your fellow Brothers and Sisters who are ailing. Your call or visit could easily brighten their day.

Membership Dues: 2024

- All Past Presidents = \$40 per year.
- Membership dues = \$80 per year.
- Members over 62 years of age, with 5 years membership in the Lodge = \$50 per year.

The following OSDIA General Law rules will be enforced:

- ALL DUES must be PAID by December 31, 2023.**
- Any member who has not paid dues by December 31, 2023 will be considered **IN ARREARS**.
- Any member who has not paid dues by April 1st, 2024, will be **IN DEFAULT**. This means . . .
 - Being dropped from the membership.
 - Re-instatement will require the OSDIA \$10 initiation fee and full dues payment.
 - Loss of senior discount (over 62 with 5 years membership), if reinstated.

Please make the effort to pay your dues on time. Your continued support and commitment are important to our Lodge.
