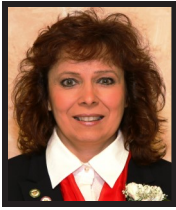

## Italian-American Culture & Heritage

### Italian Roots . . . Do you know yours? Do your children know?

Charles Carmine Antonio Baldi was an Italian immigrant from Castelnuovo Cilento in the Province of Salerno, Campania.

He arrived in the U.S. in 1876 and settled in South Philadelphia. Charles began working as a pushcart vendor which allowed him to open additional businesses. He strove to improve the economic status of Italian immigrants, while preserving their traditional cultural heritage.

He organized the First Italian Exchange Bank, so immigrant workers could save their money and send money back to relatives in Italy. He owned and operated a daily Italian language newspaper. Baldi founded a coal supply company and operated an insurance business catering to Italian immigrant workers; and a successful funeral home. He also founded a charity organization, the Italian Federation of Charitable Societies.

Charles Baldi was that rare combination of a shrewd businessman and devoted philanthropist at a time when Italian immigrants struggled for even a small amount of acceptance in America.

Charles Carmine Antonio Baldi is the great, great grandfather of Taylor Swift.
