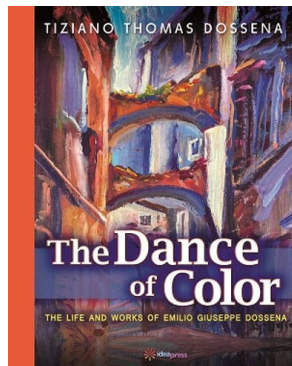

JUL & AUG in ITALY

JUL— The Palio di Siena is a horse race held twice each year, on July 2 and August 16, in Siena, Italy. The first race (Palio di Provenzano) is held on July 2, which is both the Feast of the Visitation and the date of a local festival in honour of the Madonna of Provenzano (a painting once owned by the Sienese leader Provenzano Salvani, which was supposed to have miraculous curative power).
AUG— Ferragosto (Assumption Day) is a major Italian national holiday on August 15. Local festivals take place throughout Italy where some performers dress in medieval costumes.
