

A bit of history about the portrait ...

About twelve years ago, Dr Morgan was driving past a house and noticed a portrait leaning against a trash can in the rain. She recognized it to be of Mother Cabrini. She approached the homeowner and asked if she might take it. The homeowner agreed.

The glass on the frame was cracked and when the portrait (24" x 20") was removed other damage to its edges was noticed

When Dr Morgan researched the image, she discovered it was taken in 1905 at the inauguration of the Columbus Hospital in Chicago which Mother Cabrini founded.

Dr Morgan shipped the portrait to be treated and donated the finished project to the Dr Calabro Lodge.



MEMORIAL PARK/GARDEN PROGRAM

Membership Dues: 2025
