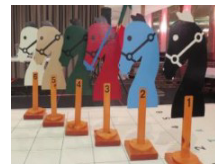
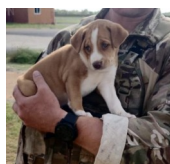

A Time to Remember ... Saints, Fathers & Solemnity

MAR 17th St. Patrick's Day - known as the "Apostle of Ireland" was born in Britain to a family of Roman citizens. Questions often asked, *Are all Romans, Italians? Was St. Patrick Italian?* Research indicates Romans were a genetically mixed ethnic group including Italians, Latins, Greeks and Etruscans. With the complex and uncertain history surrounding him, I prefer to recognize St. Patrick as the patron saint of Ireland.

MAR 19th St Joseph's Day - La Festa di San Giuseppe - believed to have been born in Bethlehem, lived and worked as a carpenter in Nazareth in Galilee. St. Joseph is the venerated patron saint of fathers, families, and workers.

In Italy Festa del Papà (Father's Day) southern Italians include St. Joseph in their celebrations. Sicilians honor him as their patron saint. According to legend, during the Middle Ages, Sicily was suffering from a horrific drought and people were eating fava beans to survive. These beans, which were cattle feed, kept many from starvation. They prayed to St. Joseph for rain, and spring rains saved the crops from destruction and the Sicilians from famine. An additional feast honors St. Joseph's attempts to keep Mary and Jesus warm and many towns hold huge bonfires (*Fuochi nella Notte*) to celebrate the end of winter. Once the fire burns down, ashes are collected to give Italians good luck for the following year.

And food is important to all. Corned beef and cabbage or Pasta con le Sarde ... your choice; or both!

And more important ... during the Lenten season, leading up to the Resurrection, reach out to the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture.
